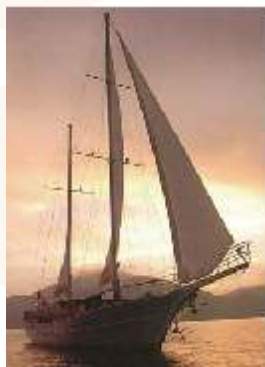


Schatz
